REPORTS TO: Principal

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES AND ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

1. Prepares for classroom activities under supervision of the teacher

- 2. Works with small groups of students to reinforce material initially introduced by the teacher
- 3. Assists individual students in need of special attention
- 4. Performs clerical duties
- 5. Guides independent study, enrichment work, and remedial work set up by teacher
- 6. Sets up audiovisual equipment
- 7. Assists teacher with non-instructional classroom duties
- 8. Checks notebooks, corrects papers, and supervises testing and make-up work
- 9. Assists in drill work
- 10. Assists with reading and storytelling
- 11. Assists small groups of students in the library and computer lab
- 12. Participates in in-service training programs, as applicable
- 13. Assists with student attendance
- 14. Assists in the administration of student check-ins and check-outs
- 15. Performs other duties as assigned
- 16. Assumes responsibility for acting as a representative of the Sheffield City Board of Education in the solution of problems which might affect his/her specific assignment
- 17. Assumes responsibility to perform any work which is assigned by the Superintendent of Schools and/or his/her representative, including the immediate supervisor
