We are pleased to inform you that Sheffield City Schools will continue to implement the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP), an option available to all schools participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs for School Year 2020-2021.

What does this mean for you and your children?

This is great news for you and your children! All students currently enrolled in any Sheffield City Schools are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at **no charge** to you each day of the 2020-2021 school year. No further action is required of you. Your child(ren) will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay a fee or submit an application. However, **a la carte snack items** may be offered at some schools. Please see the listing at the bottom of this letter for a few items and the cost.
