# MINUTES OF THE MEETING of the SHEFFIELD CITY BOARD OF EDUCATION 5:30 p.m., May 24, 2021

The Board of Education of the City of Sheffield met at 5:30 p.m., Monday, May 24, 2021, in the Annex at the Sheffield City Board of Education 300 West Sixth Street, Sheffield.
