RE: FY 2022 Accountability Reports

In order to comply with the *Code of Alabama, Section 16-6B-7* you need to make the following reports available to the media, parent organizations, and your legislators no later than December 31, 2021:

A. Financial

- 1. Exhibits A-I-I through A-I-VIII Funding and Expenditure Report for Accountability by Fund Source. The content and format of these reports are the same as Exhibits C-II-I through C-II-VIII Combining Statement of Revenues, Expenditures and Changes in Fund Balance by Fund Source.
- 2. Exhibits A-II-I through A-II-VIII Funding and Expenditure Report for Accountability by Cost Center. The content and format of these reports are the same as Exhibits C-III-I through C-III-VIII Combining Statement of Revenues and Expenditures by Cost Center.
- 3. Exhibits A-III-I through Exhibits A-III-VIII Funding and Expenditure Report for Accountability by Program. The content and format of these reports are the same as Exhibits C-IV-I through C-IV-VIII Combining Statement of Revenues and Expenditures by Program.

B. Student Achievement

The Student Achievement Report requirement may be met using the student achievement data that was released by the Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE). This information is available at the ALSDE website (www.alabamaachieves.org) under Reports & Data, School Performance, Proficiency, 2021-2022 ELA Assessment, 2021-2022 Math Assessment, 2021-2022 Science Assessment.

This data has been disaggregated and is available in several different reports. In order to avoid a large expense for printing, you may refer readers to the ALSDE website (www.alabamaachieves.org) in your report and provide a link to this report on your individual websites.

C. School Safety and Discipline

It is our desire to abide by the law, but to also save you as much paperwork and expense as possible. Since the ALSDE has copies of each Report Card and has the detailed financial data submitted by each school system, it will not be necessary to submit these reports to the department.
